

- \*Ceasefire 100 hours after ground campaign
- \*"Video Game War"
- \*Victory for coalition forces



### BACKGROUND TO CONFLICT

- IRAQ NEARLY BANKRUPT:
  - IN DEBT TO KUWAIT WHO FINANCED WAR AGAINST IRAN
- IRAQ CONSIDERED KUWAIT AN IRAQI PROVINCE
- ACCUSED KUWAIT OF "SLANT-DRILLING" INTO IRAQI OIL FIELDS



### U.S. RELATIONSHIP WITH IRAQ

- GENERALLY STABLE, BUT U.S. HAD SEVERAL CONCERNS:
  - IRAQ WAS AN ALLY OF THE USSR
  - IRAQ WAS CRITICAL OF ISRAEL
  - IRAQ SUPPORTED SEVERAL ISLAMIC TERRORIST GROUPS


• SADDAM BELIEVED THE U.S., SAUDI ARABIA, & KUWAIT WERE CONSPIRING

#### THE INVASION

- AUGUST 2, 1990 IRAQ ATTACKS & OCCUPIES KUWAIT
- IRAQI MILITARY COMMITS ABUSES
- IRAQ ANNEXES KUWAIT
- IRAQI FORCES MOVE TOWARD THE BORDER OF SAUDI ARABIA, A U.S. ALLY



### ENTER THE UNITED NATIONS

- U.N. CONDEMNS THE INVASION:
  - DEMANDS IRAQ WITHDRAW BY 1-15-91
  - PLACES ECONOMIC SANCTIONS ON IRAQ
  - AUTHORIZES THE USE OF FORCE





#### **BUILDING A COALITION**



- U.S. ASSEMBLES A COALITION (TEMPORARY ALLIANCE) OF OVER 30 NATIONS TO OPPOSE IRAQ:
  - SOME CONTRIBUTE MILITARY FORCE OTHERS GIVE \$
  - INCLUDES SOME ARAB COUNTRIES

- VIOLATION OF KUWAIT SOVEREIGNTY
- SUPPORT FOR SAUDI ARABIA (U.S. ALLY & KEY SUPPLIER OF OIL\*\*)

- IRAQ HAD:







- SOME WERE SHOWN ON IRAQI TELEVISION & FORCED TO READ STATEMENTS CRITICAL OF THE WAR











- RETREATING IRAQIS LEFT BEHIND AN ENVIRONMENTAL NIGHTMARE:
  - SET OIL WELLS ON FIRE
  - DUMPED OIL INTO THE PERSIAN GULF





### THE FIGHTING ENDS

• 100 HOURS AFTER THE GROUND ATTACK BEGAN PRESIDENT BUSH DECLARED A CEASE-FIRE

• LESS THAN 300 AMERICANS KILLED



#### **GULF WAR CONTROVERSIES**

- "HIGHWAY OF DEATH" ATTACKS TOO HARSH?
- ERROR TO ALLOW SADDAM TO REMAIN IN POWER?
  - BEYOND SCOPE OF U.N. MANDATE
  - COALITION WOULD HAVE LOST MEMBERS
  - WOULD HAVE REQUIRED LONG-TERM OCCUPATION OF IRAQ
- FAILURE OF COALITION TO PROTECT IRAQ'S KURDISH POPULATION FROM SADDAM'S REVENGE AFTER THE WAR
- RETURNING COALITION SOLDIERS REPORTED ILLNESSES AFTER THE WAR:
  - CALLED GULF WAR SYNDROME


#### **RESULTS**

- KUWAIT LIBERATED
- RETURNING SOLDIERS GREETED POSITIVELY (UNLIKE VIETNAM)
- "FEEL GOOD" WAR FOR AMERICANS:
  - TO SOME EXTENT ERASED THE GHOSTS OF VIETNAM
  - AMERICAN TECHNOLOGY WORKED (MOSTLY)
  - WAS QUICK AND COST FEW U.S. LIVES
- CONSEQUENCES FOR IRAQ:
  - IRAQI NO-FLY ZONES ESTABLISHED
  - GREAT PHYSICAL DAMAGE
  - ECONOMIC SANCTIONS IMPOSED
  - U.N. SPONSERED WEAPONS INSPECTIONS
- INCREASED ISLAMIC EXTREMISM:
  - ESPECIALLY AGAINST SAUDI ARABIA (VIEWED AS BEING ON SAME SIDE AS ISRAEL AND TOO CLOSE TO U.S.)

### Bill Clinton (1993-2001)


- \*Democrat (defeated Rep. George H.W. Bush)
- \*Longest period of peacetime economic expansion in US history (budget surplus)
- \*Signed into law NAFTA
- \*Impeached by House of Rep. for perjury and obstruction of justice/acquitted by the Senate in 1999 and allowed to complete his term in office.



# NAFTA (1994)


\*North American Free Trade Agreement: Treaty between Canada, Mexico, + US allowing for free trade (eliminates tariffs and increases investment opportunities)

# September 11, 2001 Attacks (9/11)

\*Four coordinated terrorist attacks by Islamic terrorist group al-Qaeda (Osama bin Laden)= War on Terror

\*Attacks killed 2,996 people, injured over 6,000.

\*Caused at least \$10 billion in infrastructure and property damages


















# **USA Patriot Act (2001)**

- \*Signed into law by President George W. Bush in 2001 in response to 9/11 attacks
- \*Federal legislation to strengthen security and national defense (FBI can search phone, e-mail, and financial records without court order)
- \*Constitutional???? 4th Amendment???
- \*On May 26, 2011, President <u>Barack Obama</u> signed the PATRIOT Sunsets Extension Act of 2011, a four-year extension of three key provisions in the Act: <u>roving wiretaps</u>, <u>searches of business records</u>, and conducting surveillance of "lone wolves"—individuals suspected of terrorist-related activities not linked to terrorist groups





### **War on Terror**

\*International military campaign after 9/11 attacks in 2001 to counter terrorism

\*George W. Bush stated, "Our enemy is a radical network of terrorists and every government that supports them."





# Iraq War (2003- 2011)

# \*Invasion of Iraq by a US led coalition that overthrew gov. of Saddam Hussein (WMDs)

\*The conflict continued for much of the next decade as an <u>insurgency</u> emerged to oppose the <u>occupying forces</u> and the post-invasion Iraqi government.

\*The <u>Bush administration</u> based its <u>rationale for the war</u> principally on the assertion that Iraq, which had been viewed by the U.S. as a <u>rogue state</u> since the <u>Persian Gulf War</u>, possessed <u>weapons of mass destruction</u> (WMDs) and that the Iraqi government posed an immediate threat to the United States and its coalition allies. Select U.S. officials accused Saddam of harbouring and supporting <u>al-Qaeda</u>, while others cited the desire to end a repressive dictatorship and bring democracy to the people of Iraq. After the invasion, no substantial evidence was found to verify the initial claims about WMDs, while <u>claims</u> of Iraqi officials collaborating with al-Qaeda were proven false.

<sup>\*</sup>An estimated 151,000 to 600,000 or more Iraqis were killed in the first 3–4 years of conflict.



# War in Afghanistan (2001- 2018) \*2001 coalition (US led) invasion to dismantle al-Qaeda (longest war in US history)

\*Following the <u>September 11 attacks</u> in 2001 on the U.S., which President <u>George W. Bush</u> blamed on <u>Osama bin Laden</u> who was living or hiding in Afghanistan, President Bush demanded that the Taliban hand over Osama bin Laden and expel <u>al-Qaeda</u>; bin Laden had already been wanted by the U.S. since 1998.





# **Hurricane Katrina (2005)**

\*Huge failures of the levees and flood walls protecting New Orleans, Louisiana caused flooding in 80% of city

\*Tied with Hurricane Harvey as the costliest tropical cyclone on record.

\*The criticisms of the government's response to Hurricane Katrina primarily consisted of criticism of <a href="mailto:mismanagement">mismanagement</a> and lack of <a href="mailto:leadership">leadership</a> in the relief efforts in response to the storm and its aftermath. More specifically, the criticism focused on the delayed response to the flooding of New Orleans, and the subsequent state of chaos in the city
